PC 832 FIREARMS FAMILIARIZATION

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

PC 832 Firearms Familiarization is a 24-hour course designed to comply with California Penal Code 832 as well as requirements by Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST). This course is a basic introduction to the legal aspects of shooting and safety. Topics include: handgun familiarization, safety, shooting principles and live fire exercises. Because this course is designed to provide practical hands-on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participant.

Attendance is mandatory. Students are required to arrive at <u>7:30 am on the first day</u> in order to complete the registration process and avoid impeding instructional time. Late students who miss this process will not be allowed to attend the course.

<u>IMPORTANT NOTE:</u> A Glock Model 19 9mm semi-automatic pistol is provided for this course. Personal and non-Law Enforcement Agency assigned weapons are not allowed. Law Enforcement personnel requesting to use their department issued firearm and ammunition, must obtain <u>prior</u> approval from the Interim Course Coordinator, Ray Simmons, who can be reached at (916) 570-5021 or <u>simmonf@arc.losrios.edu</u> and cc: <u>rowleyl@arc.losrios.edu</u>

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 01, 2022: Students will be required to purchase 400 rounds of factory loaded 115 grain 9mm full metal jacket (FMJ) ammunition. **Steel case and non-factory loaded ammunition are prohibited**. This is also available from the Sacramento Regional Public Safety Training Center at the cost of \$112.00 on the first day of class. This cost is **not reflected** in the student's material fees for the course. Each student will be issued a Glock model 19 semi-automatic pistol from the district for use in the course.

Students who bring unapproved ammunition and/or firearms will be dismissed from the class.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

MUST SUBMIT A DOJ CRIMINAL HISTORY CLEARANCE LETTER prior to the start of the course and must be at least 18 years of age. DOJ Clearance Letter must be no older than 90-days prior to the last day of the class.
